ORDER

ORDER No: 2020-002

WHEREAS a State of Local Emergency was declared for the City of Edmonton on March 20, 2020 at 5:21 p.m.;

AND WHEREAS the State of Local Emergency was renewed on March 26, 2020 at 3:49 p.m.;

AND WHEREAS the Emergency Advisory Committee has delegated to the Director of the Emergency Management Agency the powers and authorities under s. 24 of the *Emergency Management Act*, RSA 2000, E-6.8, during the declared state of local emergency;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That all vehicles for hire, as that term is defined in the Vehicle for Hire Bylaw, Bylaw 17400, must comply with following:
 - a. only one passenger is permitted in a vehicle at a time, unless:
 - i. additional passengers are members of the same household, individuals in a close personal relationship, or a required caregiver; or
 - ii. the size and capacity of the vehicle allows for 2 metres between each passenger and the driver;
 - b. no passengers are permitted in the front passenger seat of the vehicle;
 - c. cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be kept in the vehicle at all times and must be visible to passengers;
 - d. following each trip, all passenger-accessible surfaces including interior and exterior door handles, window and comfort controls, seat belts, payment devices, and all passenger seating areas must be cleaned thoroughly with disinfecting cleaning products;
 - e. drivers must use appropriate personal protective equipment when offering physical assistance to passengers; and

Failure to comply with this Order may result in enforcement to the full extent of the law, which may include fines and penalties.



- f. any vehicle that provides service to a passenger demonstrating COVID-19 symptoms, including cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat, or who otherwise indicates that they are at risk of having COVID-19, must be immediately removed from service and thoroughly sanitized.
